FUTURE64 IS THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S (MODOT) STUDY OF THE I-64 CENTRAL CORRIDOR FROM KINGSHIGHWAY BOULEVARD TO JEFFERSON AVENUE.

WHAT IS A PEL?

A Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) study helps transportation decision-makers by examining community, economic, and environmental goals early in the federal environmental process for developing transportation projects. The PEL will provide a platform for the community to discuss and prioritize transportation issues and improvements, help develop a vision, and create a more unified decision-making process. The PEL approach streamlines the federal project development and delivery process.



MODOT WANTS TO INVOLVE THE PUBLIC and local stakeholders to better understand how Interstate 64, transit, bike and pedestrian infrastructure, and the surrounding street network can be re-envisioned to better serve community needs. Future64 will develop several options that better position MoDOT and the community for prioritizing transportation investment decisions in both the short- and long-term future.

WHAT IS THE STUDY AREA?



I-64 CENTRAL CORRIDOR IS CHANGING!

The I-64 central corridor is developing into a hub for recreation, shopping, and living. New development initiatives are causing people to think about how possible infrastructure upgrades, such as pedestrian and bicycle access, might help support and benefit the area's future.

WHO IS LEADING FUTURE64?

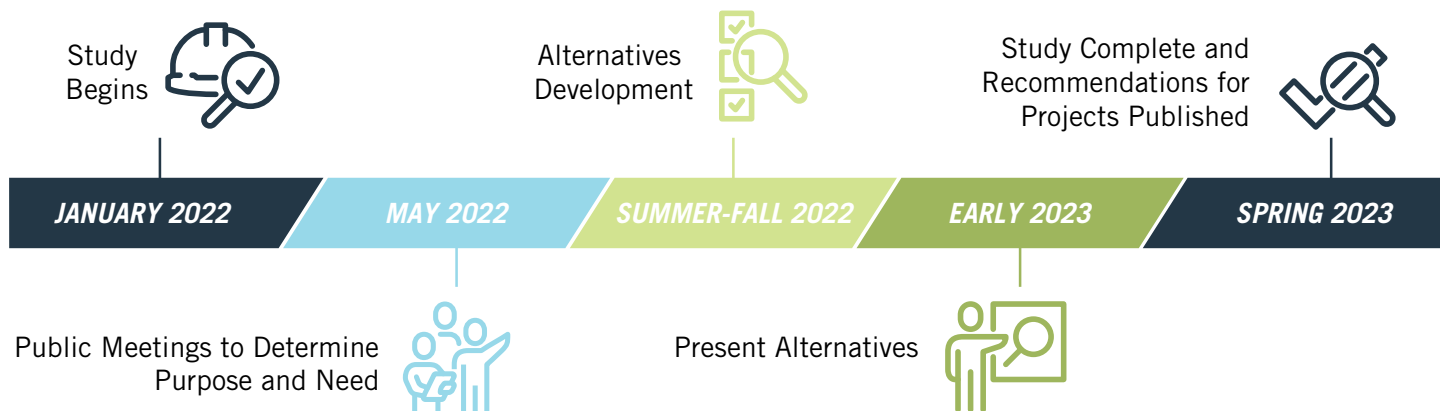
